Innovation

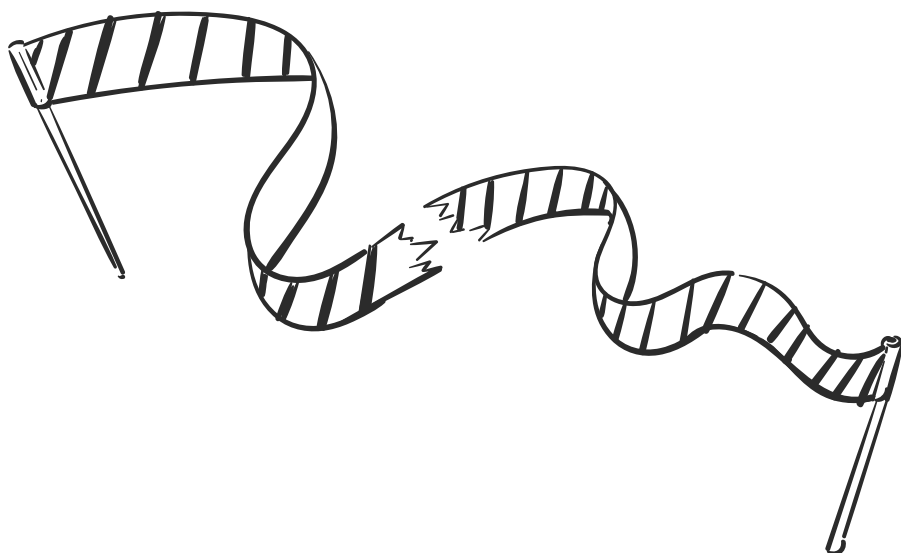
We embrace new research, technologies, and treatment approaches to stay at the forefront of the fight against cancer.

PROGRAMS & ACHIEVEMENTS

Serving Meals to attendees of Patients at hospitals

Hospitals in Delhi NCR often witness caregivers dedicating their time and energy to supporting their loved ones, often at the cost of their own well-being. To address this, we served nutritious and hygienic meals to over 10,000 caregivers across major hospitals in the region. This initiative provided comfort and sustenance during their challenging journeys.

Maternity Health Supplies

Understanding the critical need for maternal health support, we distributed maternity kits containing essential supplies to 500 expectant mothers in underserved communities. These kits ensured safer and healthier pregnancies, contributing to reduced maternal and infant mortality rates.

Health Checkups

Regular health checkups are vital for early detection and prevention. This year, we organized 12 health camps across Delhi NCR, providing free screenings for common illnesses, cancer, and other non-communicable diseases. Over 5,000 individuals benefited from these initiatives, with several receiving referrals for advanced care.

Cancer Awareness Campaigns

Educating communities about cancer prevention and early detection is a cornerstone of our mission. We conducted awareness sessions in 20 schools, 15 colleges, and 5 universities, reaching over 25,000 students and faculty members. These campaigns focused on lifestyle changes, recognizing early symptoms, and promoting a supportive environment for those affected.

Women Empowerment Initiatives

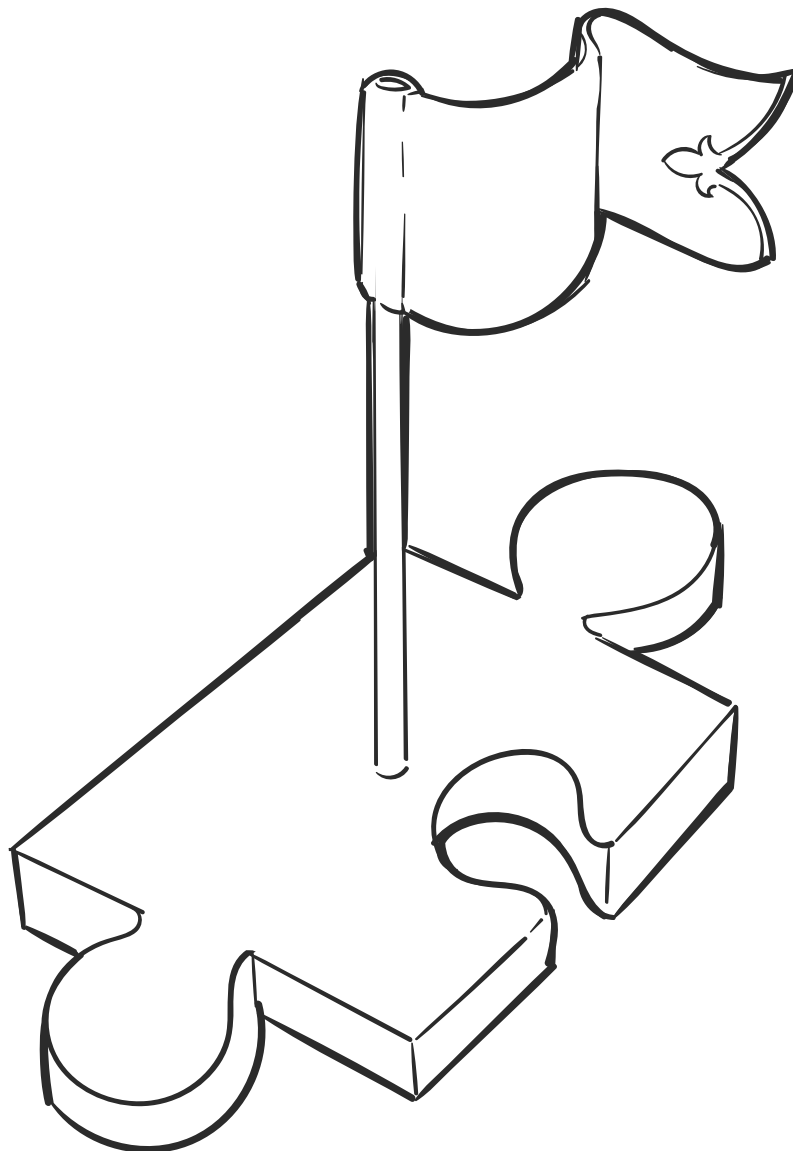
We implemented various initiatives to promote women's empowerment, including educational programs, skill development workshops, and economic support. Our goal was to equip women with the necessary tools and resources to achieve their full potential.

Women Empowerment through GDA Training

The General Duty Assistant (GDA) training program aimed at empowering women from marginalized backgrounds. Over 100 women were trained in essential caregiving skills, enhancing their employability and economic independence.

Financial Support to Cancer-Affected Families

Financial strain is a common burden for families battling cancer. We provided monetary assistance to 50 families, helping them access necessary treatments, medications, and daily needs. This support has alleviated stress and allowed families to focus on recovery.
